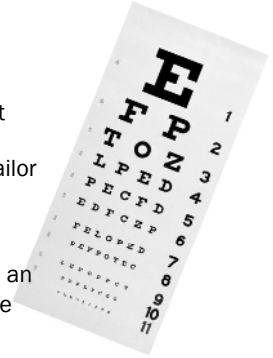
Drug Testing

This is our most frequently-requested service. We provide a variety of drug testing services including lab and MRO services, rapid results tests and third party collections. Companies count on HealthWorks to facilitate both their DOT and non-regulated testing services, that's why we manage 30 different random drug testing pools and employer consortiums with over 3,000 members. Employers can choose our popular online reporting that allows them to download or archive drug test results on our secure website.

Physicals and Injury Care

We offer a variety of types of physicals including: DOT physicals, HazMat physicals, Pre-employment physicals with back fitness evaluations, Return-to Work physicals, Asbestos physicals, Respirator physicals and Sports physicals. These physicals may include EKG's, x-rays or laboratory tests. We tailor physicals based on the employer's needs and some physicals include a back fitness evaluation or strength testing based on particular job descriptions.

HealthWorks also provides injury care and follow up for employees who are injured on the job. With an aggressive return-to-work policy, we work closely with employers to achieve the best outcome for the employee and to minimize lost time.



Respiratory Protection Services

Respiratory protection services include consulting with employers on compliance issues and with regular surveillance of respiratory issues. Services include pulmonary function testing, respirator certifications and respirator fit testing. We offer both qualitative (using saccharin or bitrex) and quantitative (using our TSI Portacount) fit testing for a variety of types of masks.

Audiometric Services

HealthWorks Northwest has thousands of ears of experience in audiometric testing and surveillance. Whether performed in one of our clinics or in our 4-booth mobile unit, we perform thousands of hearing tests each year and help employers keep accurate records and baseline comparisons. We provide tools for employers to provide education and we provide audiometric reviews for baseline revisions.



Immunizations and Other Surveillance



Whether part of a physical or as a portion of a regular surveillance program, HealthWorks Northwest provides a variety of immunizations and medical surveillance programs for workers in all types of industries. We offer Hepatitis A and B vaccinations, PPD (Tuberculosis) testing, Blood Lead profiles, MMR vaccinations, Titers and Flu shots, or other employer-requested blood tests.

Training and Education

Our most popular class is our First Aid/CPR/AED training providing a 2-year certification. We also offer classes for employers including Reasonable Suspicion For Managers Training, Blood-borne pathogens training, drug screen collection training. We also offer a variety of OSHA-certified training such as fall protection, advanced CPR and others.

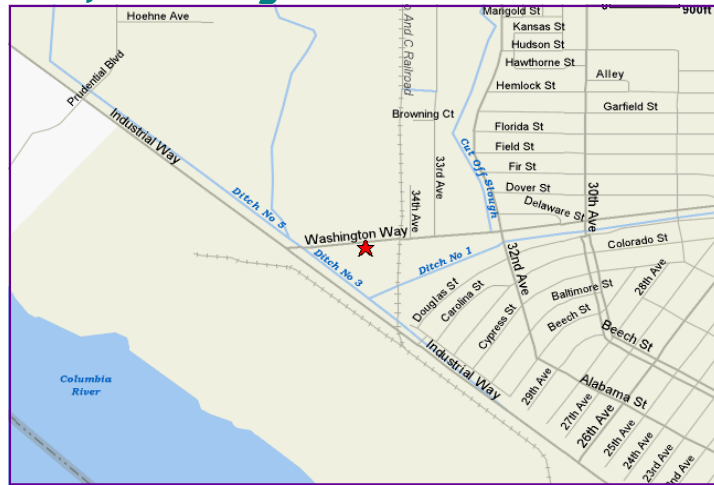
